

## GENERAL INFORMATION ARML – Penn State

### Buses - Friday Evening (7:00 – 11:30 PM) - ARML Courtesy Busing (school buses with “ARML” sign in window)

- Friday Evening Busing available for ARML coaches and participants: 7:00 – 11:30 p.m.
- **There will be 2 school buses doing a loop around campus with stops (at Waring Commons/West Halls near intersection of Burrowes Road/Curtin Road, at Forest Resources Building/East Halls, and near Thomas Building). See map.**
- Look for a small paper sign “ARML” on bus.

### Friday evening events:

- **Coaches and Proctors mandatory meetings, 8:00 – 9:30 p.m. at the Forest Resources Building, which is located between the East Parking Deck and Park Avenue (see map). Room 112 for Coaches; Room 107 for Proctors.**
- **8:00 – 9:15 p.m. math lecture by Sarah-Marie Belcastro, Thomas Building, Room 100 (auditorium).**
- **9:00 – 11:00 p.m. Song contest/karaoke/reception is in Waring Commons/West Halls (see map).**
- **Note buses are available from 7:00 p.m. – 11:30 p.m. on Friday night. See map and information above.**

### Buses – Saturday Morning (6:00 – 8:00 AM) ARML Courtesy Busing (school buses with “ARML” sign in window) – see MAP

- See Map for bus route. Saturday morning busing 6:00 – 7:00 a.m. is between stop 1 (Waring Commons) and Bryce Jordan Center (Gate A) to provide transportation to the breakfast for ARML residents in West Halls. Busing will continue from 7:00 – 8:00 a.m. for all 5 stops on bus route map to assist any ARML participant to go from Bryce Jordan Center to campus. Look for a small paper sign “ARML” on the school bus.

### Saturday Breakfast is 6:00 a.m. – 7:30 a.m. at the Bryce Jordan Center (enter Gate A). See map.

- East Hall residents are to walk to the Bryce Jordan Center (Gate A – see map).
- West Hall residents may take the courtesy bus (see map).
- Crossing to/from the Bryce Jordan Center is at the corner of Curtin Road and University Drive – enter Gate A.
- PLEASE obey the walk signal for SAFETY. Cross only with the walk signal and no traffic.

### Saturday buffet lunch will be on the concourse/main floor of the Bryce Jordan Center.

- Teams will be dismissed by the announcer to proceed to the main concourse to have lunch.

### Policies

Established policies and rules are designed to help all students and guests receive maximum benefit from their visit. Violation of any of these rules could result in immediate dismissal.

- Students are required to be punctual and participate in all scheduled activities.
- Students are prohibited from entering residence halls other than their own unless chaperoned by an adult.
- Disruptive or abusive behavior that could escalate to harmful actions is forbidden.
- Misuse or damage of University property is unacceptable. Students will be charged for damage.
- Students are expected to demonstrate respect for each other as well as all University staff members and visitors.
- Illegal substances, possession of firearms or weapons, and alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited. In addition, gambling and tobacco use are not permitted in any University facility.

### Residence Halls

- Inspect your assigned room and living area for any damages prior to your occupancy. Notify your coach immediately of any residence hall damages or concerns. Unauthorized room changes are not permitted.
- Always lock your door and keep your key with you at all times. If you lose your key, contact your coach/chaperone immediately. DO NOT WAIT! A replacement key will be issued at an additional cost.
- The residence halls will be locked at all times. **All students and coaches/chaperones are expected to be in the residence halls by 11:00 pm. Lights out by 12:00 midnight.**
- The University will not be responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- Trash should be placed in the container in the janitor’s closet. Penn State recycles.
- Fire extinguishers/fire alarms are for emergencies only. In case of a fire, remain calm and proceed to the nearest exit (use stairs only – do not use elevators). The staff in the building will respond to alarms.
- **Be sure to turn-in your residence hall key to the housing staff in Findlay Johnston Commons before leaving campus to avoid a lost key charge (\$58 per missing key) to your coach.**
